Old Business

School Supply Kits (Shannon)

- The flyer went home with students and the emails went out. Orders are due by July 1. No extensions available.
- The PTO does not make a profit off these kits. We do it at cost to keep the price as low as possible for families.
- Mike Lynch offered to help with sorting and distributing the kits in August.

New Business

5th Grade Field Day (Shannon)

This will be on May 25th. The parent organizers have used \$250 of the PTO money budgeted for the event, toward the deductible for inflatable games. They have \$250 remaining.

Budget (Eve)

There are lots of outstanding receipts now as the school year closes. A few changes from the balances as handed out at the meeting:

- The Family Fun Events revenue went up to \$3,131.66. (food truck night)
- The Clinic Needs expenses went up to \$303.48.
- The Principal's Fund expenses went up to \$1,785.26.
- The Front Office Staff Reimbursements expenses went up to \$199.99.
- The Recess Equipment expenses went up to \$1,059.94.
- The Safety Patrol Field Trip expenses went up to \$705.30.
- The Specials Teachers Reimbursements expenses went up to \$2,623.97.
- The Speech Teachers Reimbursements expenses went up to \$468.16.
- The Teacher Reimbursements expenses went up to \$10,021.64.

Also the Memory Walk Brick expenses have not been paid out yet. That expense balance will not remain \$0.

Picnic Tables/Benches (Eve)

- We bought 5 picnic tables and three benches from one company for the new seating area outside the cafeteria. Eve is checking whether the tables come with anchors or whether we need to order those separately. The total cost with shipping was \$10,081.50.
- We bought on ADA compliant table; it had to be from a different company. It is a double-sided ADA table, so both ends are usable. The ADA table was \$2,255.90.

Mini Grant (Eve)

- Mrs. Hoy put in a mini grant request for equipment so she can to use the new kiln with her K-5 art classes. The kiln came with the art room renovation. The equipment includes special gloves and pieces to go inside the kiln to hold students work while it is fired. The total is \$864.26 plus shipping. This mini grant was APPROVED.

Parent question about food truck rally (Mike Lynch)

We received \$120 from Pam's Cones, \$200 from the BBQ truck, still waiting on Uncle Louie's, the Greek food vendor, and Kona. (Eve)
